Return to School Options

Roseville Community Schools is dedicated to ensuring students receive the best instruction possible. Following the guidelines from the State of Michigan, we are prepared to offer students full-time face-to-face instruction or a virtual only online learning environment. Below are the highlights of each program to help parents make the best decision for their family. Please visit our web site at <https://rosevillepride.org/> for more details.

Option 1

*Full-Time Face-to-Face

- Students (PreK-12) will attend five (5) days per week during regular school hours.
- GSRP students will attend four (4) days per week, based on grant requirements, during regular school hours.
- Students will be taught by Roseville Schools' teacher(s)
- Students must follow all safety measures as provided by the district, including frequent hand washing/use of hand sanitizer, face masks, and social distancing whenever possible.
- The district will provide all required safety equipment.
- Students choosing not to follow all safety measures will be moved to the virtual only option.
- If the state moves back to phase 1-3, all students will move to virtual learning.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served daily.
- Buses will be running. All students (PreK-12) must wear a mask while on the bus.
- Latchkey will be available. Masks must be worn unless students are outside and maintaining social distancing whenever possible.

Option 2

Virtual Only – 100% Online

- All students (PreK-12) selecting the virtual option are considered Roseville Community Schools students.
- There will be a set schedule during the regular school day that students will be expected to follow.
- Online instruction will be monitored for attendance, active participation, and academic integrity.
- Students are eligible to participate in all extra-curricular activities.
- Coursework will count toward a student's academic progress and G.P.A.
- Students will receive a teacher(s) from Roseville or our online resource partner. A Roseville mentor will be assigned to any student using our resource partner.
- Meals will be available for pickup at designated locations.
- All courses meet NCAA Clearing House requirements.
