Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Eastland Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mr. Beato for assistance.

For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the "Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)". A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been identified with a label this year.

Eastland Middle School is composed of approximately 301 students. Eastland has 97 students in 6th grade, 111 students in 7th grade, and 93 students in 8th grade. Eastland has 130 females and 171 male students.

Attendance percentage---84.30%

Eastland used I-Ready as the national achievement teats for the 2021-2022 school year. This benchmarking test is giving to all students three times a year in the fall/winter/spring. 2021 Fall results:

- The percentage of 6th graders at/above benchmark in math is 28%
- The percentage of 6th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 40%
- The percentage of 7th graders at/above benchmark in math is 22%
- The percentage of 7th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 34%
- The percentage of 8th graders at/above benchmark in math is 25%
- The percentage of 8th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 42%



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Fall of 2022:

- The percentage of 6th graders at/above benchmark in math is 30%
- The percentage of 6th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 45%
- The percentage of 7th graders at/above benchmark in math is 24%
- The percentage of 7th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 41%
- The percentage of 8th graders at/above benchmark in math is 25%
- The percentage of 8th graders at/above benchmark in ELA is 38%

Teacher conference----24% in 2021 (held 'virtually' due to COVID 19) 82% in 2022

We are proud of the progress and growth our students have shown and we strive to keep that momentum up each year. Our staff is committed to working in collaborative teams to ensure that all students learn at high levels so that they are prepared for high school and beyond. Teachers work to identify essential skills that are required in each course. Once those are identified, they work together to design engaging activities, assessments, and intervention so that student learning is constantly being monitored and students get extra support if they need it. Students that need extra support in math and ELA are placed in a math or ELA support/attack class. These classes are designed to get students support and to get students at their benchmark.
