We also start our state standardized testing in April for grades 3-5. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders will be tested on their ELA and Math skills, while 5<sup>th</sup> graders will have tests in ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies. We will have a kickoff assembly for those students before the tests begin to go over what to expect. Please make sure students are getting rest each night so they are prepared for the testing days.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS
