Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2023-2024 educational progress for Fountain Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Dr. Trobaugh for assistance.

For the 2023-2024 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as a HAS NOT BEEN GIVEN ONE OF THESE LABELS

Fountain Elementary has been able to identify some key challenges for the school to address in order to close learning gaps and help raise proficiency for our students that score in the bottom 30% in M-Step testing and IREADY tests. We currently use *Wonders* to facilitate reading instruction for every student in grades K-5 to help increase their fluency and vocabulary. The Wonders reading program provides a more in depth look at comprehension and word craft aimed at helping

students be better readers for information and understanding. The Wonders program also has a great writing component for grades K-5, that is used for instruction. We have the support of an Early Literacy Specialist and Instructional Aide that provide early intervention. We currently use *Everyday Math* as our math instruction to facilitate an increase in student achievement. We also benefit from having a Resource Room teacher on staff.

For the 2023-2024 school year, Fountain Elementary School served approximately 325 students in grades Preschool through 5th grade. Fountain also houses 1 self-contained special education programs for students with learning disabilities in grades 4 and 5.

Students are assigned to Fountain Elementary School according to their home residence. Families also had the opportunity to apply for a transfer to and from other schools within Roseville Community Schools. In addition, Roseville Community Schools participated in the school of choice program throughout Macomb County. The attendance at conferences was 80% in the fall of 2023. Staff at Fountain Elementary continues to focus on our goal areas of reading, math, science, and social studies in our School Improvement Plan. We have also added a behavioral strategy, PBIS, which is used to support our students and building climate by promoting positive behavior. All staff members are involved in the planning of this school improvement plan. We are continuously collaborating and reviewing data from local and state assessments to indicate where support is needed.

-The percentage of 3rd grade students that were proficient or advanced on the Spring 2023 M-STEP was as follows:

English Language Arts – 11%; Math – 6%

-The percentage of 4th grade students that were proficient or advanced on the Spring 2023 M-STEP was as follows:

English Language Arts – 8%; Math –7%

-The percentage of 5th grade students that were proficient or advanced on the Spring 2023 M-STEP were as follows:

English Language Arts – 11%; Math – 5%; Social Studies – 4%; Science – <10%

Congratulations to all those students who excelled in their academics and extracurriculars. We are proud of our National Elementary Honor Society as well as our PBIS program. We are grateful to the students, staff, and parents for all their hard work and achievements in 2023-2024 and look forward to another great year!
