ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

When a student misses 2 days a month..

They will miss **20 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **30 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **1 YEAR** of school by graduation.

When a student misses 4 days a month..

They will miss **40 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **120 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **2 YEARS** of school by graduation.

Parking/Student Drop Off:

- ♦ For the safety of all children, those parents who will be driving their children to school and wish to utilize our drop off lanes **Please do not park in the drop off lanes and exit your vehicle. The designated drop off areas should not be used as parking spaces.** The police do monitor our parking lot on a regular basis and will issue you a ticket if you are parked illegally. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
- ♦ If you wish to walk your child to their designated waiting areas, please pull into one of the many designated parking spots available and walk your child to their class line.

ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION

Roseville Community Schools have complied with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act, commonly referred to as AHERA. AHERA provides a framework for addressing asbestos problems in public and private elementary and secondary schools. The regulations provide a comprehensive scheme for schools to access and respond to potential asbestos problems in their buildings.

This compliance was carried out by:

- Having all buildings inspected by an accredited inspector
- Developing an asbestos management plan for each school and submitting a copy to the Governor
- Providing copies of the report and management plan which are on the district-wide web file and can be viewed by any interested party by calling the Buildings and Grounds Office.
- Re-inspecting all school buildings every six months

**ROSEVILLE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS
NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY**

Statement of Policy

It is the policy of the Roseville Community School District that no discriminatory practices based on gender/sex, race, religion, color, age, national origin, disability, height, weight, or any other status covered by federal, state or local law be allowed in providing instructional opportunities, programs, services, job placement assistance, employment or in policies governing student conduct and attendance. Any person suspecting a discriminatory practice should contact the Civil Rights Coordinator at Roseville Community School District, Administration Building, 18975 Church St., Roseville, MI 48066 or call 586-445-5513.

Grievances will be handled under the procedures set forth in Policy GAAD.

Grievance Procedure

Section 1: Any person believing that the Roseville Community School District, or any part of the school organization, has discriminated on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender/sex, age, disability, height, weight or marital status, may file a grievance with:

Grievance forms are available from any building principal or from the Administration Building.

Section 2: All grievances will be processed through the following steps:

- A. A written statement of the grievance, using the district's grievance form, shall be submitted to the Civil Rights Coordinator.
- B. Upon receipt of the completed grievance form, the Coordinator will conduct an investigation and notify grievant of the results, including any remedial measures. Normally, the investigation will be concluded within (30) thirty school days.
- C. Within (10) ten school days, the grievant may appeal, in writing, to the Superintendent of Schools, who will make a written decision, normally within (30) school days.

The complete grievance procedure is found in Roseville Community School Board Policy GAAD, which can be obtained from the Coordinator.

Behavior Point Flow Chart

Green Elementary Students are Respectful, Responsible, and Ready!

Student behavior expectations are defined, taught, and modeled by ALL staff.

The behavior offenses listed in the first column will be handled by the Teacher and are worth one point. Depending on the severity of the incident, Principal will also handle behavior.

Behavior Offenses (1 point):

- Violation of Classroom or School Wide Rules
- Unsafe or Harmful Behavior
- Inappropriate Language or Actions
- Disrupting Class
- Disrespect toward Teacher or Peers
- Refusal or Defiance
- Teasing or Harassment (mild)
- Misuse, Destruction of Property
- Not following Hallway, Bathroom, or Drinking Fountain Rules
- Lack of Focus/Academic Refusal
- Leaving Room without Permission
- Loss of Control (outburst, yelling)
- Misuse of Electronic Device (cell phone, iPad, laptop)
- Other: _____

Lunchroom:

Poor behavior will be handled by Lunchroom Supervisors.

Discipline point will be assigned by Lunchroom Supervisor or Principal.

The following behaviors will be handled by the principal and can result in automatic suspension:

- Fighting
- Physical Aggression
- Threatening Behavior
- Bullying (repeated, targeted)
- Theft, Destruction

Green Elem. Explanation of Behavior Systems for Families

PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports) & Hornets Hive:

- Purpose of PBIS System is to award **positive** behavior.
- Each student has their own PBIS Badge with QR code.
- PBIS "points" turn into **Hive Bucks** to shop for items at the Hornets Hive.
- Hive Bucks may be saved and used at any time but must be spent by the end of the school year. They do not carry over.

Behavior Point Flow Chart and Discipline Points:

- Purpose of Discipline Points is to track **negative** behavior.
- Students are expected to follow all classroom & school rules.
- Students who do not follow rules will earn a discipline point. Incident will be written up on **Discipline Referral Form**.
- Student must have parent sign form & return the next school day.

Steps to Discipline Referral Form:

Green Elementary has put procedures in place to support students in their behavior choices by communicating with parents **BEFORE** student receives 10th point and a suspension is given. The purpose of the Discipline Referral Form is to **have open communication with parent as each behavior arises**.

- **Point 5:** Teacher will call parent to discuss.
 - Parent must acknowledge 5th point with Teacher through phone call or dojo message. If parent does NOT acknowledge 5th point, student will have indoor silent recess until teacher-parent contact is made.
- **Points 8 and 9:** Student Assistant Specialist or Support Staff will call parent to discuss.
 - Parent must acknowledge 8th and 9th point.
- **10th point is a suspension:**
 - Principal, Mrs. Ambrose, will call home to inform of suspension. Appointment will be made for Re-entry meeting to take place within 2-3 days of suspension.
 - Re-entry meeting will be held with student, parent, teacher, support staff, principal and SRO (School Resource Office, Ms. Nicole McDonald) to discuss next steps and **Tier II Behavior Plan**.



Green Elementary School-Wide Rules

Rule 1: CELL PHONE policy...

Cell phones are not allowed at school. Phones must be turned OFF and collected by teacher or held in main office until dismissal. Phones may not be kept in backpack or desk. *(District policy per Mr. Blaszkowski, Superintendent).*

Rule 2: HOODIES...

Keep all sweatshirt hoods or jacket hoods completely off your head.

Rule 3: PURSES, BELT BAGS...

Students may not carry purses, belt bags, etc... during school time. (Exception is to/from bathroom).

Rule 4: PLAYGROUND RULE...

NO FOOTBALL GAMES! Students may throw football back & forth like playing catch. No tackling or tagging, etc.
