### **ATTENDANCE**

The number of absences and tardies has been increasing weekly. The State of Michigan requires that all children attend school on a regular and consistent basis. This includes early releases and half days. School districts are required to report students with excessive absences/tardies to the Truancy Officer. The accumulation of 10 late arrivals equals one unexcused absence. "Late arrival" or "tardy" means arriving for class or school activity after the established commencement time, unless excused. If your child has a doctor or dental appointment—please be sure to call the office to verify the absence and bring in verification of the appointment.

When children are tardy or absent from school, they miss out on consistent instruction that is needed to develop basic skills. Arriving to school <u>late</u> not only disrupts the class, but your child misses out on important instructions for the day as well as portions (or all) of the first subject of the day. Please help them to succeed by getting them to school—on time each day.




