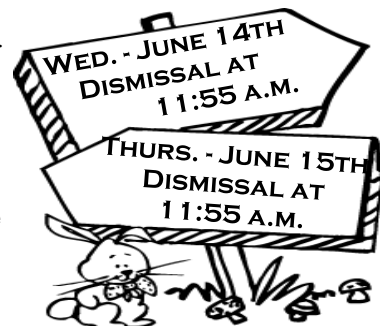


### **Desk Clean Out Day! - Tuesday, June 13th**
