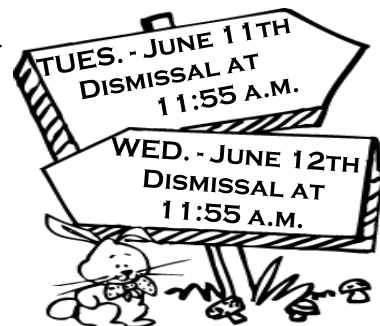


### **Desk Clean Out Day! - Monday, June 10th**
