Classrooms will be doing lots of fun activities for March is Reading Month. See the attached calendar for activities.

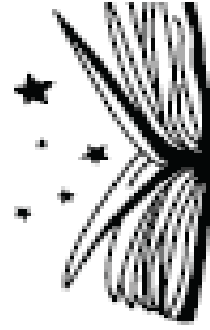
