As we enter March, I wanted to provide all of our parent(s) and guardian(s) with some updates about the final months of the school year since the last two and a half months of this year will be

As a reminder, starting this summer, Summer Credit Recovery will cost \$200 per class. Students are also limited to the number of classes they can take in credit recovery per year. IMPORTANT INFO FOR ALL PARENTS TO KNOW: State Testing and School Calendar Changes

As we do every April, RHS will be having students participate in the required State of Michigan Assessments.

We will have a "Change of Building Schedule" for April 10th and 11th to allow us to have students participate in testing in a small, focused environment to help ensure their success:

Wednesday, April 10

- 10th grade students report 7:40 10:30 to take the PSAT 10. Breakfast will be provided.
- 11th grade students report 10:30 2:45 to take the PSAT. Early lunch will be provided to 11th grade only
- 9th and 12th grade students do not have school on this day.

<u>Thursday, April 11</u>

- 9th grade students report 7:40 10:15 to take the PSAT 8/9. Breakfast will be provided.
- 11th grade students report 10:15 2:45 to take the ACT WorkKeys. Early lunch will be provided to 11th grade only.
- 12th Grade reports 1:30 2:45 pm for their Spring Senior Class Meeting to go over the end of the year and Prom, Senior Checkout requirements, Cap and Gown pick-up and Graduation prep info.
- 10th grade students do not have school on this day.

Students in our Cognitively Impaired Special Education Program who take the Mi-Access as their required state assessment will not report either day.

Bus schedules, more information about specific schedules, and school expectations for students on their specific testing days specific days will be shared as we get closer to April 10th and 11th.




Steenland Elementary's Young Fives program visited the Auto Shop at RHS on February 23.

The younger students learned about shop safety before taking a tour of the facility. They also learned what makes vehicles run and about the tools the Panther Mechanics use to work on them.





Visitor Entrance, Drop off and Pickup Instructions

- The RHS Visitor Entrance is Door #1. This door is accessed by parking in the Visitor Parking lot located in the North Lot.
- Student pick up and drop off is in the NORTH LOT. Please pick up drop off at the Athletic Entrance following the traffic pattern on the map.
- 3. The South Lot is for staff parking and Bus Drop Off/Pick Up ONLY.
- 4. Student parking is in the North Lot. Students must purchase a parking pass from the Main Office for \$40 to park at school.
- Normal St. Curbside drop off should only occur on the west (school) side of the street, not the east (private homes) side. This prevents students from having to cross the street at our busiest times of day, especially when it is dark.
