Welcome to the 2023 - 2024 school year! We are excited to partner with you again, or if you are a new family, for the first time, to work with you and your child on their path to Graduation. This is the first in a series of newsletters you will receive each month to keep you informed about all that is happening at RHS. This month's edition is full of the many "need to know" items parents should be aware of at RHS. Please keep this handy and use it as a resource throughout the year.

By now, all families should have received our summer mailing with valuable information and forms to start the school year. If you did not receive one, please contact us to make sure we have the correct contact information and so you can complete all necessary forms.

All families at RHS will receive an email each Sunday evening outlining events and important info to know for that upcoming week. We have already begun sending these emails. If you have not seen one, check your spam/junk email folder. If it is not there, contact us so we can make sure we have your preferred email address.

A few other important points of note as we start the school year:

- Our school day starts at 7:40 am each day. That is when instruction starts. Help us by making sure your student is on time.
- Sign up for and use the Parent Portal. This allows you instant access to your student's grades, attendance, and the ability to message teachers. It is a tool all parents should use. Make sure your Parent Portal settings indicate you want to receive automated weekly progress reports.
- RHS is a closed campus. No outside food or drinks are allowed to be delivered. All students get breakfast and lunch for free.
- All visitors to RHS, including those who wish to check out a student, must have a valid ID. Those who wish to check out a student must have been listed on the student contact list that came in your summer mailing. No student will be released to someone not on this contact list. If you need to update this list, contact the school.
- Make sure your email is up to date. Except for our summer mailing, all other materials, including report cards, are emailed to the home.
- All students have lockers to secure their belongings. No student has to share a locker.

Please reinforce with your student that cell phones are to be away and out of sight during instruction. Please refrain from calling your student during the school day and interrupting instruction, instead call the school and we will deliver the message.

We do look forward to working with you this year. If you have any questions or concerns, do not hesitate to contact me.

Visitor Entrance, Drop off and Pickup Instructions

- The RHS Visitor Entrance is Door #1. This door is accessed by parking in the Visitor Parking lot located in the North Lot.
- Student pick up and drop off is in the NORTH LOT. Please pick up drop off at the Athletic Entrance following the traffic pattern on the map.
- 3. The South Lot is for staff parking and Bus Drop Off/Pick Up ONLY.
- Student parking is in the North Lot. Students must purchase a
 parking pass from the Main Office for \$40 to park at school.
- Normal St. Curbside drop off should only occur on the west (school) side of the street, not the east (private homes) side. This prevents students from having to cross the street at our busiest times of day, especially when it is dark.



To obtain a parking pass you must have a valid driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. Parking passes cost \$40 and can be purchased in the Main Office. Student Parking is allowed in the North Lot only with a parking pass.

Campus Policy

Roseville High School has a closed campus.

This means students cannot have lunch delivered to them.
All students get free lunch and breakfast every day.
Students may also bring a cold lunch from home if they so choose.

A closed campus also means students are not allowed to leave for lunch.

Students that do leave campus without permission will not be allowed back in the building; they will be sent home and suspended for the next day.

Class/Instructional time will not be interrupted for delivery of forgotten items.

Safety Drills

To help students prepare for emergencies, schools routinely practice drills for fire, tomado. lockdown/internal threat.

Annual Asbestos Notification

Roseville Community Schools have complied with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Act, commonly referred to as AHERA. AHERA provides a framework for addressing asbestos problems in public and private elementary and secondary schools. The regulations provide a comprehensive scheme for school to access and respond to potential asbestos problems in their buildings.

This compliance was carried out by:

- 1. Having all buildings inspected by an accredited inspector.
- Developing an asbestos management plan for each school and submitting a copy to the Governor.
- Providing copies of the report and management plan, which are on file in each of the schools' administrative offices and can be viewed by any interested party.
- Re-inspecting all school buildings every six months.

Statement of Policy

It is the policy of the Roseville Community School District that no discriminatory practices based on gender/sex, race, religion, color, age, national origin, disability, height, weight, or any other status covered by federal, state or local law be allowed in providing instructional opportunities, programs, services, job placement assistance, employment or in policies governing student conduct and attendance. Any person suspecting a discriminatory practice should contact the Civil Rights Coordinator at Roseville Community School District, Administration Building, 18975 Church Street, Roseville, Michigan, 48066 or call (586) 445-5513.

Grievance Procedure

Section 1: Any person believing that the Roseville Community School District, or any part of the school organization, has discriminated on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender/sex, age, disability, height, weight or marital status, may file a grievance with:

Grievance forms are available from any building principal or from the Administration Building.

All grievances will be processed through the following steps: Section 2:

- A written statement of the grievance, using the district's grievance form, shall be submitted to the Civil Rights Coordinator.
- Upon receipt of the completed grievance form, the coordinator will conduct an investigation and notify grievant of the results, including any remedial measures. Normally, the investigation will be concluded within (30) thirty school days.
- Within (10) ten school days, the grievant may appeal, in writing, to the Superintendent of Schools, who will make a written decision, normally within (30) school days.

The complete grievance procedure is found in Roseville Community School Board Administrative Regulations - 8007-AR, which can be obtained from the coordinator.
