Senior Quick Shoots for Yearbook Photo (if not using a Senior Portrait in the yearbook)	\$10 (no photo packages available for purchase with the Quick Shoots)	January 17 th
Parking Pass (required for student vehicles)	\$40	September
Senior Parking Spot to Paint	\$40 Deposit (must purchase Parking Pass)	September
Homecoming Ticket	\$15 (single ticket for dance)	October
All outstanding school fees and fines. Required to participate in graduation ceremony.	Varies. Notifications will be sent by our Accounts Clerk throughout the year.	Senior Checkout Date
Senior Hoodie and Sweatpants	\$55 - \$65 (cost vary based on size)	Watch For Information
Yearbook	\$65 (cost increases after November to &70.00)	September - October
Senior Lawn Sign	\$25	March-June
Prom Ticket	\$60 (single ticket for dinner and dance)	May
