



- The Price is \$80.00 (\$40.00 is cost of parking pass, \$40.00 is a deposit. The deposit will be returned when your spot is painted over at the end of the school year). Senior Parking Spot Summary
- Parking Spots shall be in the North Parking Lot.
- A four inch border between the yellow line of the parking spot and your painting must be included in your design and this border You are responsible for providing all supplies. Water based exterior paint is the only acceptable paint type to use.
 - should be marked off using blue painters tape.

Guidelines For Your Design Sketch: Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Any design associated with gangs, advertising drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene slogans, or promote illegal activities will not be allowed nor approved. You cannot use handicap symbols or traffic symbols that may cause confusion. You may include your name, jersey number, instrument you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans and anything unique to you that meets administrative approval. Make it fun!

Paint Requirements:

WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the ONLY type of paint that can be used. Students will also need to leave an approximately four inch unpainted border between the yellow parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. Please use blue painters' tape to ensure this border is accomplished (consider sharing with others). All paint supplies will be the responsibility of the student.

What To Bring To Paint

Be sure to bring your approved design/sketches with you when you paint. Also, you will be responsible for all paint brushes, rollers, paint pans and paint tape. A broom to sweep off your spot before painting will save you lots of time. You will want to bring lawn chairs, stencils, rags for cleaning, sacks or bags to dispose of trash, a drop cloth and paint clothes.

Senior Class Personal Painted Parking Spot Policy

- 1) Submit your design when paying for your spot with Mrs. Ange Jentz in the Main Office. All design submissions and payments must be received by Friday, September 8th.
- 2) Once your design is approved you will be able to pick your spot from a map.
- 3) You have to supply your own paint and brushes/rollers/clean up supplies.
- 4) Your parking pass number is required to be painted in the bottom right corner of your space as you enter and must be visible once you park.
- 5) We will establish a day in May for the paint over. Once the space is painted over black on that day, the \$40.00 deposit will be returned to the student.
- 6) Administration reserves the right to retain the deposit and paint over black any spot that is painted inconsistently with the approved design.
