Summer Learning:

Students complete the track of their reading each month. They are also encouraged to write a short entry each week. Packets will be due back here at RMS by Friday, September 5, 2025. All students who return their completed packets will receive a reward. If you need a book, come pick one up at RMS in the main office vestibule. Tuesday, July 1 at 6:00 pm on the Library lawn

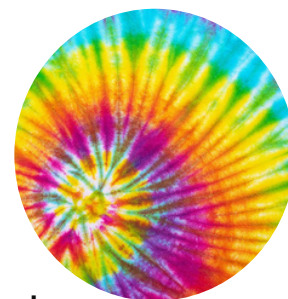
