It is critical that students continue to maintain their academic growth over summertime. Taking a complete break from learning cause students to fall into the "summer slide". This means that students academically lose critical skills. Below are some ways to help prevent this from happening.

### Summer Learning:

The district offers reading and math camps. This gives students a great opportunity to keep learning over the summertime.

Middle School Math Mindset Camp: <u>Middle School Math Mindset Camp Registration</u>
This half-day math program is for current Roseville Community Schools students who are completing grades 5-7 in June of 2025.

Middle School Readers and Writers Camp: <u>Middle School Readers and Writers Camp Registration</u> This half-day reading and writing program is for current Roseville Community Schools students who are completing grades 5-7 in June of 2025.

RMS offers a summer math and reading packet. This practice will help your child review skills learned and are encouraged to complete the Summer Reading Challenge. Students complete the track of their reading each month. They are also encouraged to write a short entry each week. Packets will be due back here at RMS by Friday, September 5, 2025. All students who return their completed packets will receive a reward. If you need a book, come pick one up at RMS in the main office vestibule. We have a couple of different books students can pick from.
