COLD WEATHER

Now that the cooler weather has arrived, please be sure your child is properly dressed for the cold weather. Your child should have a warm coat or jacket, boots if necessary, as well as gloves or mittens, and a hat to protect against the cold. Students are permitted to enter the building at 8:25 a.m.


During recess, students will go outside for at least some time as long as the actual temperature and the wind chill are not below 10° Fahrenheit, and the playground is not too wet. Please encourage your child to wear their cold weather gear during recess. It's a good idea to put an extra pair of socks in your child's backpack in case his or her feet do get wet.

Normally, students who are too ill to take part in outdoor play are considered to be too ill to be in school. Therefore, we request that parents DO NOT send notes asking to keep their child in during recess. Indoor supervision is not available. We will only accept a doctor's note excusing a student from outdoor recess.

If weather/road conditions should ever necessitate the cancellation of school, you will be notified by the district and also the television. When day class is cancelled, adult education and all child care programs will also be cancelled.

Attendance Policy

Parents, be aware that the MISD attendance office monitors the <u>entire</u> school day as scheduled by the district. In other words, late arrivals and early dismissals that violate the school day could result in a referral to the attendance officer.
